**Max 3 lessons a week, one training ride and one hack. Includes grooming when necessary, basic supplies, feed and laundry. Full board included. Show grooming and maintenance. Fly spray, body clipping and tack are not included. No refunds or credits for lessons not taken.

***Full Board includes grass or mix hay four times a day. Twice a day stall and water cleaning. Bedding comfortable for horse as needed. Daily turn-out. Twice daily feeding of grain (WSH provided purina products) and owner supplied supplements. Blanketing, hoof cleaning and fly spraying. Barn has auto fly spray system in summer. Use of daily groomed and watered arenas, common areas, and wash racks.

Twenty four hour notice is required to cancel a lesson.

Blankets and sheets will be sent out for cleaning and repairs as needed. You will be billed for this service.

REQUIRED: All riders/horses must have signed rider liability/boarding/training contracts on file in the office. A current coggins test, all vaccination records and insurance information must be on file as well.

Wasatch Sport Horses Horse Show Fees

Customers cancelling less than two weeks prior to the first day of the horse show are liable for grooms' expenses, shipping costs, trainer expenses and grooming and tack stalls.

DESCRIPTION OF FEES

Schooling Fees \$65 a day for horses not in full training
 \$40 a day for horses in full training

Trailering: \$0.55 per mile

Groom: \$50/day + tip

•Stall set up including bedding, water buckets, and personal tack trunk •Tack stall, curtain, and landscape set up •Grooming •Tacking & untacking
•Blanketing/ un-blanketing •Horses brought to the ring •Bathing
•Bandaging/wrapping horses legs •Feeding/watering •Administering medications •Stall cleaning •Shipping preparations-wraps, meeting hauler, etc
